Kentucky men charged with fishing tournament fraud

BENTON (AP) — These fish stories were, in fact, too good to be true.

Two fishing buddies were charged with 10 felonies after being accused of cheating in fishing tournaments on Kentucky Lake and Lake Barkley on the Kentucky-Tennessee line.

Dwayne E. Nesmith, 43, of Island, and Brian K. Thomas, 31, of Dawson Springs, were indicted on nine counts of theft and attempted theft.

The men allegedly snatched five live bass in a fish basket at the Relay for Life Buddy Bass Tournament on April 30, and then scooped them up for the weigh-in.

Nesmith and Thomas were witnessed picking up the fish early on the morning of April

30, then putting their catch in the boat, said Kentucky Department of Fish and Wildlife Resources Sgt. Bill Snow.

That sparked an investigation into tournaments the pair had previously won, Snow said.

The two men were arrested Tuesday.

2006 New York Bass Federation Six Man Team Event

Imagine about 100 bass boats and 200 top anglers representing 28 Bass Clubs in the Federation. The combination of trying to represent our club well, find a good partner in the draw, adapt to changes in weather and the fish, have the stamina to fish for four straight days and traveling over four hundred miles are enough to make this old LIBer's bones ache. I find it so challenging and so exciting that I fear that I am addicted to it. I have fished on many Six Man Teams before but this year was just different. I was honored, due to my status as Anger of the Year, to co-captain the team with Brendan Cuccinello. Steve Socko, Nunzio Praeto, Dan McGarry and Greg Keisling rounded out your representatives.

Dan, Greg and Brendan were our boaters and with Nunzio, they traveled to Ogdensburg on Wednesday. Steve due to work issues and me with family stuff followed on Thursday. Dan and Steve met up and I went with Greg for an afternoons practice. We basically eliminated water and patterns by catching very little. Nuzio and Brendan had found the right stuff! That night we met and strategized. The Smallies were relating to four conditions. A large flat which drained into strong current with weeds, rocks and a steep drop off into 14-24 feet. A tube needed to be dragged along the bottom. On Friday Nunzio fished with Greg, Steve with Danny and I with Brendan. We refined the pattern. Brendan and I had three doubles of wonderful pig smallies and I had one close to four pounds and Brendan had one over 5. We then went to the draw.

At registration we had to display our New York and Canadian fishing licenses, eat a BarBy and find our partner for Saturday. We each drew good boaters, which makes all the difference. Theoretically, each angler has four hours at the helm but in reality the rider is at the mercy of the boater. Saturday found wind and rough water. Some boats travelled over 35 miles each way. I had a great day with George Locke who fished shallow weeds and it was not until we found our teams four conditions that we really caught fish. Steve had a frustrating day with a partner who threw a jerkbait but Nunzio hit the big time bringing in a big bag of smallies. Our three boaters brought nice limits to the board. When we looked at the big board we realized that Long Island Bassmasters was in 5th place out of 28 teams with almost 70 pounds of Smallmouth Bass. We then had to pair up for Sunday, eat dinner and strategize once again. We shared tackle and laid out spots for each of us to fish.

Sunday found calmer water but rain. I had a frustrating day with a partner who couldn't get into the pattern, a dead trolling motor and defective steering on the boat. At one point I had to jump off the boat, into the water to push him off the rocks. I found the fish, caught two smallies for almost six pounds but couldn't get to the fish because of the boater who was a great guy but out of the game. Everyone else on the team came in with a limit and a few astounding ones. The final results will show that Danny put up a good show. Steve roared back with a nice bag. Greg had two fine days and Nuzio and Brendan just kicked butt! Unofficially Long Island Bassmasters finished 6th overall and this tired, old co-captain is in awe of what my teammates accomplished.
