**All boats must be registered, properly insured, and equipped with functioning livewell.
All contestants must have a valid Connecticut 2010 fishing license on them.**

All State, Local and DEP rules must be followed. Any breach and or violation of Connecticut DEC, and or violation of Candlewood Lake Authority rules {as example equipment violation, violation of the 45 mile an hour speed limit, fishing and or fish in designated no fishing or off limits areas} will result in an immediate disqualification and forfeiture of all tournament fee's.

Each participant must have a Coast Guard approved PFD which must be worn when gas motor is running.

All fish will be released back into the lake after weigh in. No culling of dead fish. There will be a 4 ounce penalty per dead fish weighed in. Any short fish will result in disqualification of team.

8 Fish Limit per boat. Teams are limited to two persons per boat. Only Largemouth and Smallmouth Bass will count with a minimum length of 12". Heaviest Total Weight determines winners. There will be a lunker award for the largest single bass by weight.

In the event of a tie by weight, the payout for the two places will be combined and equally split between both teams.

A team consisting of only 1 angler may only weigh in 5 legal bass.

No Trolling, or Fly fishing. Artificial baits only. Pork may be used. One rod per person may be used at a time.

All fishing and landing of fish must be done from inside participant's boat.

All fish must be brought to the scale by a team member in an official Long Island Bassmasters Tournament Bag.

Each boat will idle out to the point where check boat is waiting, and Started in number order by the check boat.

At check in, display your boat number to the check boat. DO NOT PULL YOUR BOAT, IF YOU PULL YOUR BOAT YOU WILL BE DISQUALIFIED! When the weigh in begins, each boat will be called into the scales by boat number. When your boat number is called, beach your boat in front of the weigh station, where you will be given an official weigh in bag. After your catch is weighed, one team member may head to your vehicle and get in line to pull out your boat.

If you for any reason a team decides to leave early, they must return their boat number to another competitor or a Tournament Official. {DO NOT TAKE NUMBER CARDS HOME}

The results will be considered final upon the announcement of winners by the tournament committee. All protests must be made to tournament officials before the scales close at weigh in. All protests will be decided at the tournament site by club officials. All decisions are final.
